

# 2021 / 2022 Registration Document

## **ONLINE REGISTRATION**

Hockey Canada has upgraded their registry to HCR 3.0 which will require some initial set-up.

**Registration will open August 2**<sup>nd</sup> and close September 20<sup>th</sup>. If you miss those registration dates you risk eligibility for tryouts or participation in the upcoming hockey season.

**Checking Clinics:** Players who are new to U15 or U18 Competitive hockey and interested in playing checking hockey must complete an approved checking clinic before tryouts in October.

**U15 Major, U18 Major, High School:** Players trying out for U15 Major, U18 Major, or High School are <u>encouraged to register</u> with their home hockey association. Payment not required. If you are successful in making one of these teams, please contact <u>admin@halifaxhawks.ca</u> to have your registration removed; if unsuccessful, payment is required to proceed to Hawks tryouts or Recreation hockey.

**U23 League:** If you are over 21 years of age you will have to contact <a href="mailto:admin@halifaxhawks.ca">admin@halifaxhawks.ca</a> to register, the new HCR 3.0 doesn't accept registration with date of births after 21 years of age. Please include your name, date of birth, and address in that email.

#### **Payment options:**

Players who make a competitive team are required to pay a competitive fees to cover added costs for ice time, officials, and league fees; additionally, a sock fee may be required for standard issued home and away hockey socks. **Competitive and sock fees are paid by players to their team in November.** 

### **REFUNDS**

All requests for refunds must be made in writing to <a href="admin@halifaxhawks.ca">admin@halifaxhawks.ca</a>. We ask that you remain patient during the busy time of registration for a response.

- Refunds will be assessed on a case-by-case basis
- Approved refunds may have a \$35 administration applied
- If you participated in tryouts, you will not be refunded for the tryout fee portion
- Prior to October 15: Refunds for Competitive hockey will be considered
- Prior to November 15: Refunds for Recreational hockey will be considered
