

Travel Permits

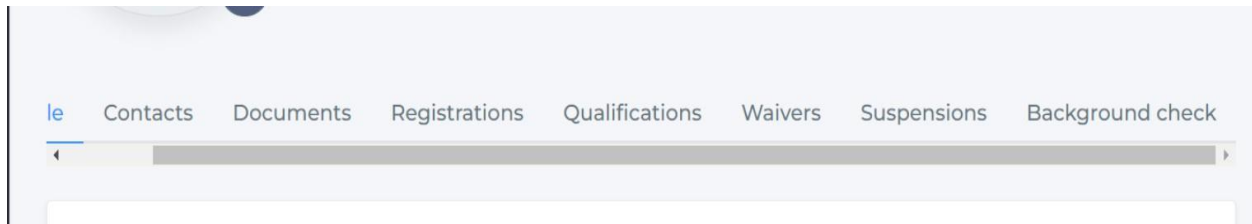
Looking to get a travel permit?

In order to obtain a travel permit for your team you must;

1. Have a profile on the Spordle account.
2. Be registered with the team you are associated with (i.e. team manager or coach).

You are only able to apply for travel permit for the team you are associated with. Below is an example of what the front page of your profile will look like, it will also include a heading that says “travel permits”



Regional Directors are responsible for approving travel permits. Typically, the Regional Directors (who are Hockey Nova Scotia) volunteers only check their region’s travel permits once per week to approve them.

Once you have applied for a travel permit, you will receive a permit number. Once you receive that number, that is all you need. You do not have to wait for the permit to say approved.
